



MULGRAVE BASKETBALL

SENIOR WAREHOUSE COMPETITION

2026 RULES

1. All games will be played on Thursday nights
2. Size 7 game balls will be used for Mixed competition
3. Team Nomination of \$200.00 is required when you register online. If any players are not registered with Mulgrave they are required to register in Basketball Connect and purchase a Basketball Queensland membership (365 days or 14 day memberships available-can only be used once).
4. Teams must have a minimum of four (4) players and a maximum of 10 players.
5. To be eligible to participate in the Senior Mixed Warehouse Competition. Players must be turning 15 years of age and over in the year of the competition.
6. Game fees of \$70 must be paid upfront prior to the start of each game
7. Game times will be scheduled for Thursday nights 6.15pm, 7.05pm and 7.55pm.
8. Games will be played at Smithfield SHS – court 2 depending on availability
9. All players must be registered in Basketball Connect. If a player joins a team and plays without first registering the game will be recorded as a forfeit.
10. Each team must supply one scorer for the game they are playing. The scorer can be one of the players who have been substituted out of the game.
11. Players are permitted to play for one team only.
12. Game times will consist of 2 x 20 minute halves with a three (3) minute half time. There are no timeouts during the game. Substitutions can be made at any time as long as they do not disrupt the game. The clock will not stop at all, except in the case of a major injury or incident at the discretion of the referee and Mulgrave staff member on duty. Drawn games will stand – no overtimes.
13. Each team MUST have matching coloured playing singlets or Tshirts and have visible numbers for the referees and scorers to see. Shorts with pockets are not allowed. Jewellery must be removed prior to taking the court.
14. Players are permitted 5 fouls only before they are disqualified from the game as per FIBA rules. Fouls are to be recorded in Basketball Connect scoring app.
15. Games are played under modified FIBA Rules and will be slightly modified to accommodate a social game. All fouls will result in an inbounds throw-in at closes point of infraction for the non-fouling team. Jump balls will be played from the centre circle (no possession arrow).
16. Technical, Unsportsmanlike and Disqualifying Fouls will be penalized as per the FIBA rules
17. All players and spectators must abide by the Mulgrave Basketball Code of Conduct.
18. Respect the referees. Verbal abuse of officials and/or other players will not be tolerated.
19. Respect the equipment and facilities of Mulgrave Basketball.
20. Respect the rights of others and avoid the use of derogatory language based on gender, race or impairment. Audible swearing and foul language may result in removal from the game and/or stadium
21. Fighting will not be permitted and may result in a ban from the stadium.

22. Any unsportsmanlike conduct that occurs during game time that is deemed to be unacceptable by Mulgrave staff may result in players being disqualified and/or the game being called off. Bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated, including behaviour and actions which may be seen as belittling or ridiculing the opposition players or referee.
23. Forfeit Fines of twice the game fee will apply if less than 48 hours' notice is given to Mulgrave Basketball.
24. Mulgrave Committee may waive or reduce this fee only in exceptional circumstances.

MULGRAVE MIXED COMPETITION RULES

1. In mixed games there is a minimum of 2 females on the court at any time but a maximum of only 3 female players allowed in the key. If there are 4 or 5 females on the court then only 3 designated players are allowed into the key on offence or defence. The others are not allowed into the key.
2. Male Players are not to enter the keyway at either end of the court in offence or defence in mixed competitions. (Referee to call a violation on the offending team).
3. A maximum of 15 points can be scored per player. When all players in the team have scored the maximum 15 then the scoring for each person starts again.
4. If a player is less than 15 points and exceeds this total from his/her last shot, these points will count.
5. If a player with 15 points scores, the basket shall not count. The defensive team will inbound the ball from the baseline but the made basket will not be recorded on the scoring app.
